FOOTBALL PARKING GUIDELINES

We appreciate your cooperation in promoting a safe environment by adhering to football parking guidelines.

Lot Opening times:

/ Saturday game: 7:00 AM for a 12:00 PM kick-off, 9:00 AM for a 3:30 PM kick-off, and 1:00 PM for a night kick-off.

• Donor parking passes will include one pass for each home game.

/ Lost or stolen passes will not be replaced.

/ Any parking pass which appears to be duplicated or forged or is improperly displayed will be confiscated.

Based upon the circumstances, the original pass may be forfeited for the remainder of the season without refund.

/ Passes must be hung from your rearview mirror at all times while on campus. The bottom portion of the pass must be surrendered to a lot attendant upon entry.

· Purchaser of a parking pass is responsible for the conduct of their guest.

Please be sure you and your guests are respectful and courteous to all game day employees and other fans. MSU reserves the right to suspend/revoke parking privileges for unruly or inappropriate behavior. This includes behavior of guests using your pass, even if you are not present.

• One pass = one space.

/ Each pass entitles parking within the confines of ONE marked parking space. You are PROHIBITED from extending your vehicle and/or any tailgating paraphernalia (tents, awnings, games, etc.) outside of your marked space and into any adjoining spaces or travel lanes. Travel lanes must be open for emergency vehicles.

/ Obstructing the travel portion of the parking lot is a violation of Ordinance 31.04. Violators may be ticketed in addition to the revocation of parking privileges for future football seasons.

Tailgating

/ No tailgating areas, including green space, are included or promised with any specific parking space (common courtesy of fellow Spartans will allow everyone to locate appropriate tailgating space either within or surrounding your designated lot).

/ Corporate/Large party tent space (greater than 10' x 10') is available in specific locations around Spartan Stadium. Requests will be accepted starting April 1. For more information, please call Fox Sports Properties (517-884-8828).

• "Drop-offs" of items or persons are prohibited in donor parking lots.


Recreational Vehicles (RV)

A recreational vehicle is defined as taking up more than one marked parking space. You must possess a RV pass if you wish to park a RV, motor home, stretch limo, bus, etc. Vehicle cannot exceed 32 feet in length and must fit within the confines of two parking spaces.

Prohibited items include:

Tents larger than 10' x 10', couches or upholstered furniture, kegs or other common source containers, drinking game structures and/or paraphernalia, trailers of any type including pig roasters.





NEW FOR 2018

- 1) Lot 79E (southeast stadium lot) will be permanently removed as a new STEM building will be constructed.
- 2) Lot 70 (west of Wonders Hal) will no longer be a donor parking option, as it will be utilized for entry for public parking at Cherry Lane.
- 3) Public parking will re-locate from Munn Intramural Field to Cherry Lane (corner of Shaw Ln. and Harrison Rd.).

 No vehicles will be allowed on Munn Intramural Field. Entrance to public parking at Cherry Lane can be made at Lot 70.
- 4) Fan Fest, previously located at the corner of Shaw Lane and Red Cedar Rd., will now be located at the northeast corner of Munn Intramural Field.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING SPACES

Accessible parking spaces are available in each donor lot and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis when lots open on game day. Any donor wishing to utilize an accessible parking space must:

- 1) Present a valid disability placard or plate; AND
- 2) Present a valid parking pass for the parking lot in which the accessible parking space is located.

Accessible parking with shuttle service is located in Lot 48 at the corner of Trowbridge Road and Farm Lane.
