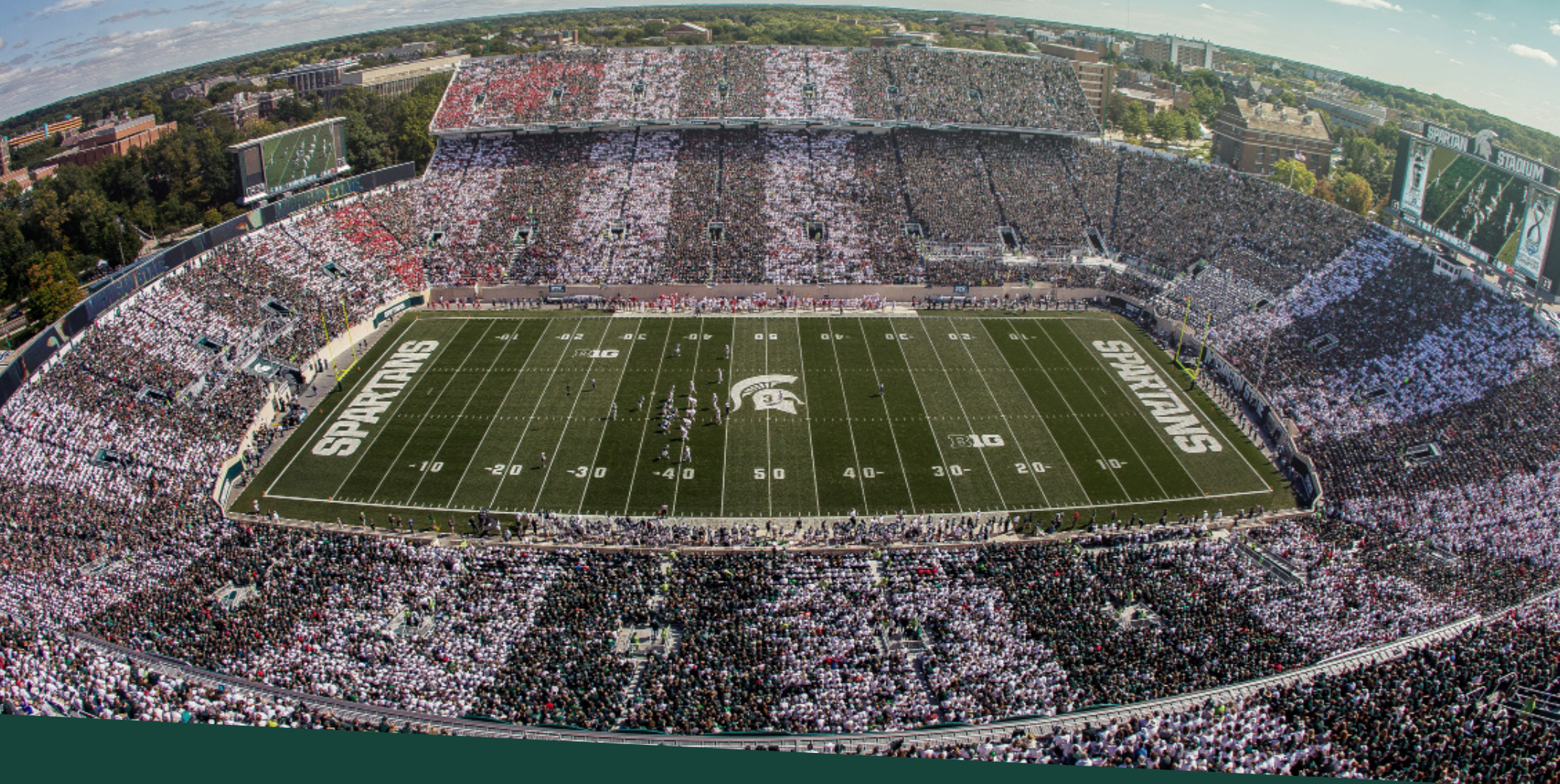

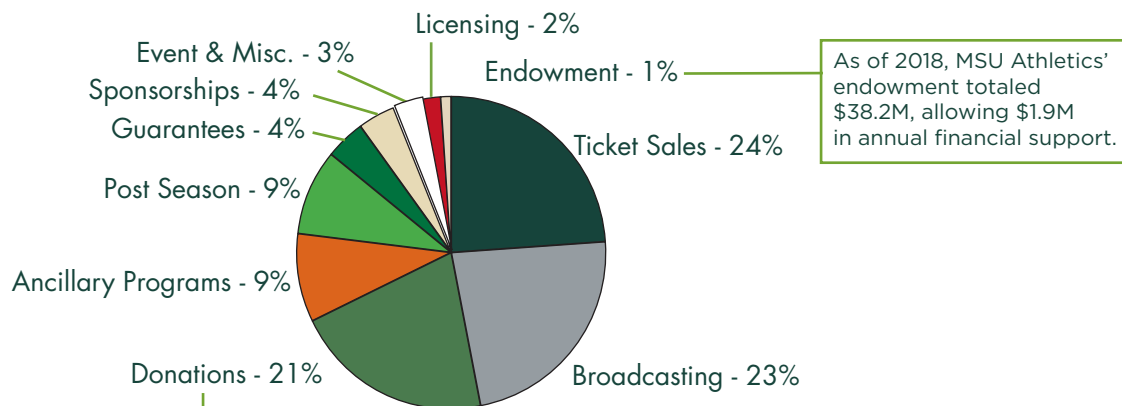

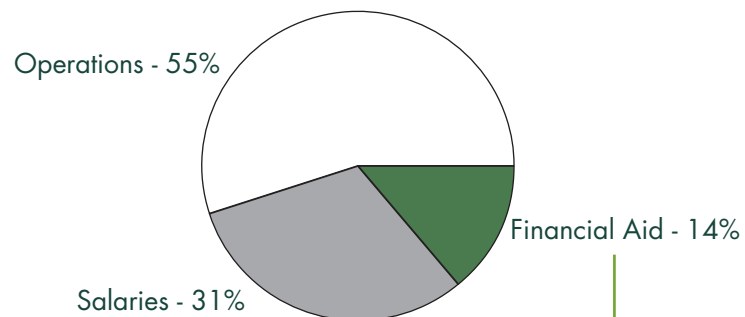
MSU ATHLETICS

For prospective student-athletes, nothing makes more of a first impression than the stadium, arena or field that they will call home while attending Michigan State. Our venues, arenas, and fields are where our student-athletes learn life lessons - teamwork, adversity, triumph - each day from dynamic and inspiring coaches.

Current facility projects being fundraised for include the Munn Ice Arena Addition, a football office renovation at the Skandalaris Football Center, and the Gilbert Pavilion/Tom Izzo Hall of History.



The MUNN ICE ARENA ADDITION will provide a dramatic focal point in the heart of MSU's intercollegiate athletic facility district, while serving as a "front door" to our beloved hockey facility. The student-athlete experience is paramount in recruiting and ensuring sustained success. Through the addition, MSU Athletics aims to enhance the student-athlete experience through improved locker facilities, a new weight room, lounges to build camaraderie and focus on academics.

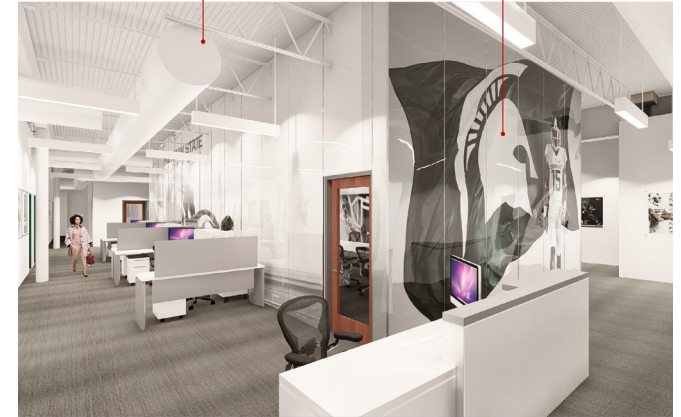

FOOTBALL OFFICE RENOVATION

In August 2008, Spartan Football moved into the 25,000-square-foot Skandalaris Football Center that featured new team, staff and position meeting rooms, coaches' offices and The Demmer Family Hall of History. Designed for efficiency and with the most advanced technology, the facility created an ideal environment for teaching and learning. In the ten seasons since the dedication of the Skandalaris Football Center, Michigan State has experienced unprecedented and sustained success in football.

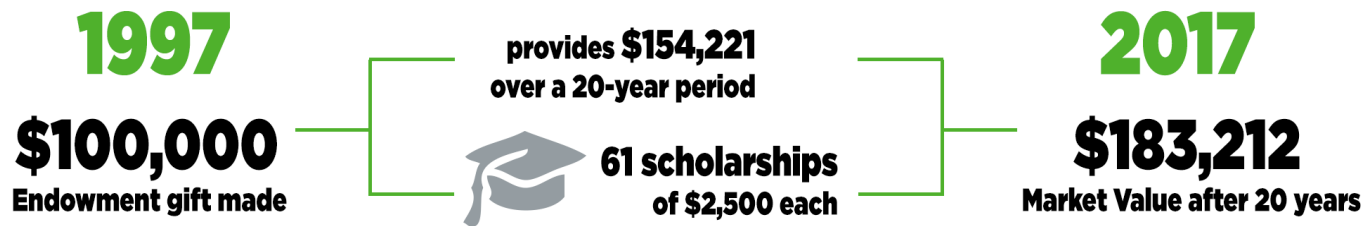

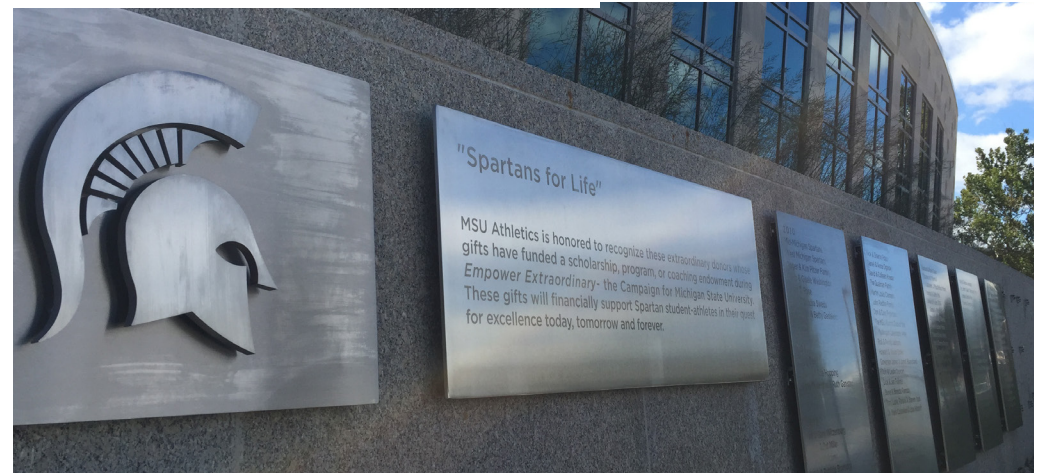
ENDOWMENTS

ensuring the success **OF TOMORROW**

Endowments are meaningful as they offer a dependable source of funding in perpetuity. MSU Athletics offers the ability to support scholarships, programs or coaches, ensuring an ever-lasting source of funding to these key areas. You may choose to name your own endowment or give to an existing endowment.



Individuals investing in a scholarship endowment are provided the opportunity for donors to meet the Spartan student-athlete awarded their scholarship endowment and learn how their gifts are impacting today's students.



During Empower Extraordinary, the campaign for Michigan State, donors contributing gifts of \$50,000 or more (over 5 years) made to an endowment had their names etched onto the "Spartans For Life" Endowment Wall (see above). Located at the north end of Spartan Stadium, the endowment wall serves as a landmark for those who have left a legacy and forever associated themselves with MSU Athletics. Recognition for future endowment gifts will be determined at a later date.

SCHOLARSHIP endowments allow student-athletes to pursue excellence in the classroom while playing the sport they love. Each year, MSU Athletics awards over 500 Spartan student-athletes financial aid - \$15 million and rising - for tuition, room and board, and books. These dollars are helping our Spartans earn a world-class education while preparing them for life beyond MSU.

Scholarship Naming Opportunities:

Position Scholarship: \$350,000 to fully endow

Athletic Scholarship: \$50,000 - \$349,999

Ralph Young Endowment: Less than \$50,000

PROGRAM endowments ensure perpetual support, laying the foundation for funding operational expenses that are so vital to build and sustain championship programs in all 25 varsity sports. A well-supported program endowment often differentiates a struggling program from a great program capable of consistently competing on a national level.

Program Naming Opportunities:

Varsity Sport: Starting at \$1M to fully endow

Program Support: \$50,000 - \$999,999

COACHING endowments assure that Spartan Athletics can meet and respond appropriately to the daily standards being set for intercollegiate coaching salaries. It is vital that our elite coaches and their respective staffs remain fixtures in the MSU Community as coaching continuity is so important to recruiting elite student-athletes.



FOOTBALL SEATING

SCHOLARSHIP SEATING | Most seating options within Spartan Stadium require a seat premium, in addition to the cost of the season ticket. Amounts are determined by the zone in which your season tickets are located (see map to right). Seat premiums help offset nearly \$15M in scholarship cost for all Spartan student-athletes on scholarship. Effective January 1, 2018, seat premiums are no longer tax deductible. Please consult your tax advisor(s) for details.



PREMIUM SEATING

HUNTINGTON SUITES | Huntington Suites at Spartan Stadium offer a host of amenities designed to provide you and your family, clients, and business associates with the ultimate game-day experience. Huntington Suites are available for the season or on an individual game basis (limited availability). Amenities included: priority parking pass, game day programs, private restroom, elevator access, operable window, and two TVs. In-suite catering available at additional charge.

HUNTINGTON CLUB | The Huntington Club, located on the 4th floor of Spartan Stadium, offers a host of amenities designed to provide you with the ultimate game-day experience. Club seats are open to the stadium, while at the same time covered and heated in inclement weather. The air-conditioned and heat-equipped Club area has comfortable living room style furniture, multiple TVs, private restrooms, and elevator access. If available, Huntington Club seats require a seat premium of \$3,000-\$6,500 per seat depending on location, in addition to the cost of the season ticket.












SIDELINE CLUB | The spacious and comfortable Sideline Club is comprised of 1,174 chair back seats in the first 7 rows from the field between the 20 yard lines behind both the MSU and visitors bench. If available, Sideline Club seat premiums start at \$1,750 per seat, in addition to the season ticket cost.

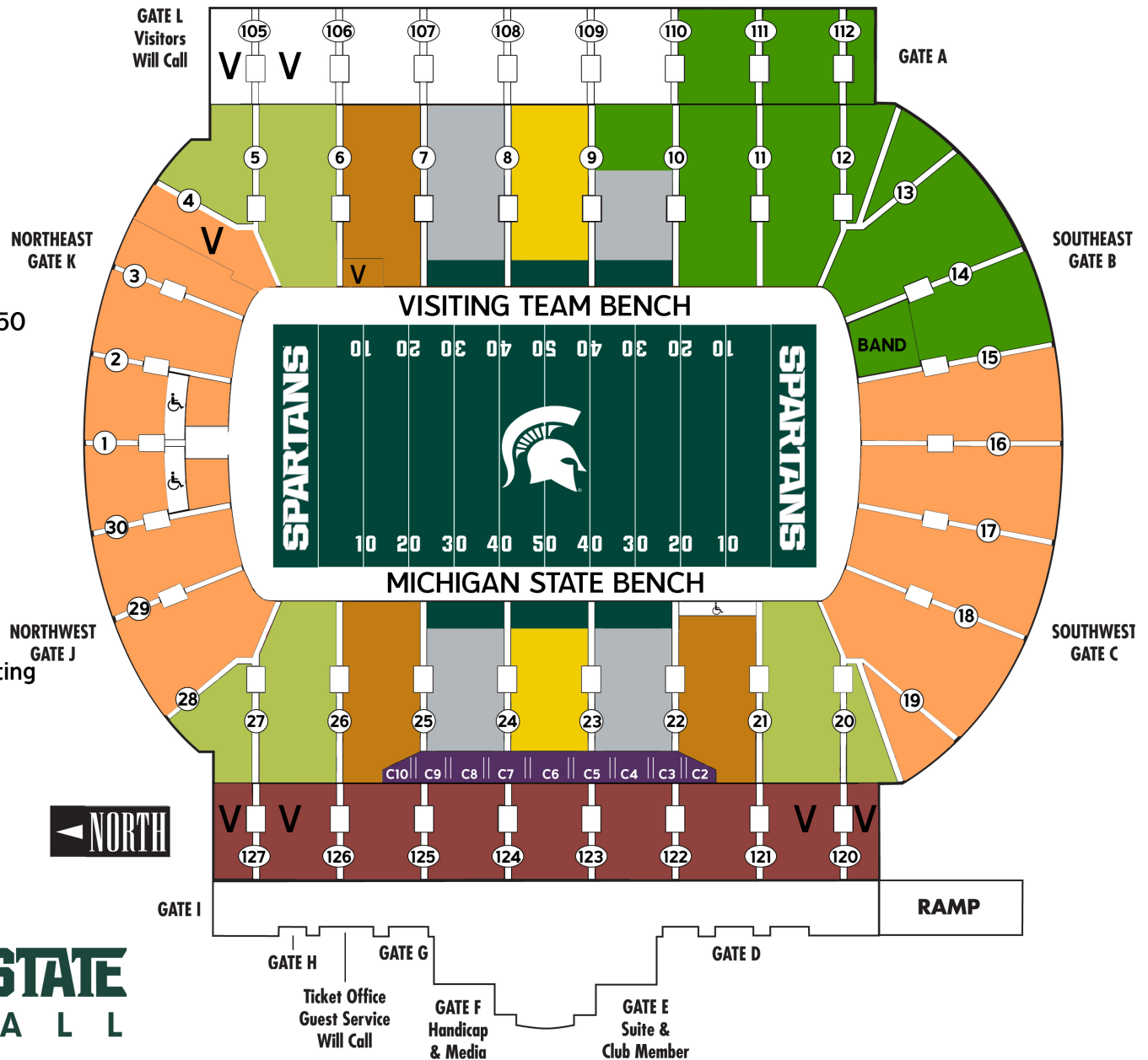

MEN'S BASKETBALL SEATING

SCHOLARSHIP SEATING | Chair-back seats in the lower level and the center three sections of the upper level in the Breslin Center require a seat premium, in addition to the price of the season ticket. Seat premiums help offset nearly \$15M in scholarship cost for all Spartan student-athletes on scholarship. Seat premium amounts are determined by the zone in which your season tickets are located (see map below). Effective January 1, 2018, seat premiums are no longer tax deductible. Please consult your tax advisor(s) for details.

COURTSIDE SEATING | The closest seat location available for men's basketball. Enjoy amenities such as padded chair back seats, complimentary buffet service, TV's and a game day program. A hospitality room is also included providing an area for contributors to gather and engage with buffet-style meals.

SEAT ADJUSTMENTS | All season ticket holders are subject to the Breslin Center Seat Adjustment which occurs every 4 years (next scheduled for summer 2022). Seat Adjustments will be based on the Spartan Points system, with the men's basketball season ticket holder with the highest number of cumulative Spartan Points selecting first.



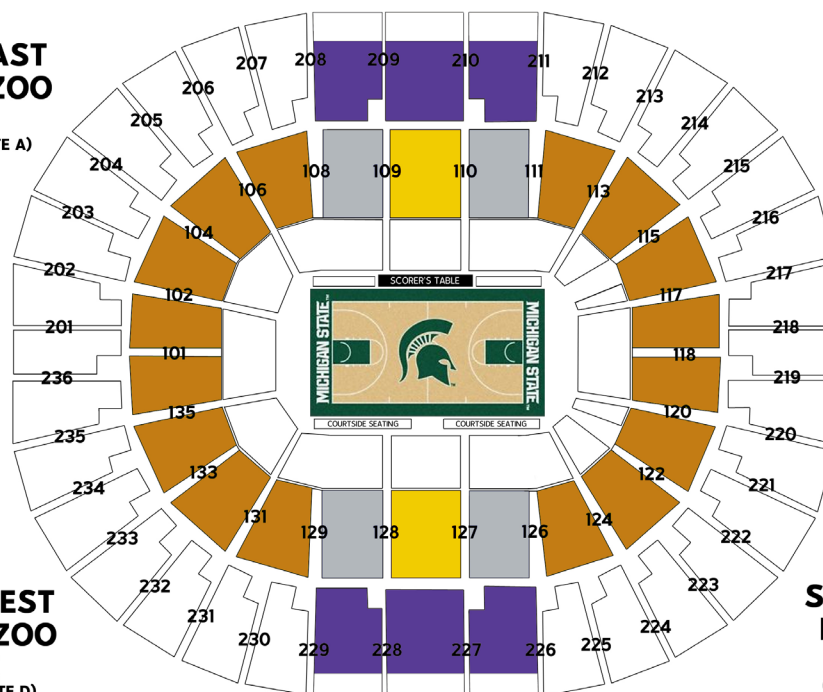
BRESLIN CENTER SEATING CHART

HUNTINGTON SUITES | A private view of Spartan Hockey from the second level of Munn Arena. Suites are available for the season or on an individual game basis (limited). Amenities included: 12-16 seats, priority parking, in-suite catering, complimentary program, TV, private restrooms and elevator access.

HUNTINGTON CLUB | An excellent view of all the action on the ice from a private club on the second level of Munn Ice Arena. Amenities included: padded theatre style seating, priority parking, complimentary buffet service, complimentary program, multiple TV's, private restrooms and elevator access.

ADDITIONAL PREMIUM SEATING

MSU Athletics offers premium seating opportunities for the best seats in the venue along with amenities to make your game-day an enjoyable one. Whether in Munn Ice Arena, the Breslin Center, or Jenison Fieldhouse, you can enjoy the championship effort put forth by our student-athletes in their pursuit of excellence.

Each premium seating opportunity requires a seat premium in addition to the cost of a season ticket. Seat premiums offset nearly \$15M in scholarship cost for all Spartan student-athletes on scholarship. Effective January 1, 2018, seat premiums are no longer tax deductible. Please consult your tax advisor(s) for details.

COURTSIDE SEATING | Courtside seating offers the closest seat available for women's basketball and volleyball. Amenities: padded chair back seats, a priority parking pass, complimentary buffet service (women's basketball only), complimentary game-day program.

SPARTAN POINTS

Benefits, such as parking and post-season ticket requests, are issued in donor priority order:

1st – Annual Spartan Fund donor level, which is based upon your annual gifts to MSU Athletics

2nd – Spartan Point Ranking within your donor level.

Spartan Points* reward longevity, loyalty and generosity of our Spartan Fund donors. Spartan Points are utilized as a tie-breaker when determining priority within your annual donor level.

POSTSEASON & AWAY GAME OPPORTUNITIES

Spartan Fund donors are provided priority to request postseason & away game tickets from MSU's official allotment for games, such as the Big Ten Championship game, bowl games, College Football Playoff and NCAA Tournament.

Donors will receive information regarding ticket opportunities when made available by the Spartan Ticket Office.

Seating locations (if ticket request is fulfilled) will be fulfilled in donor priority order, determined first by Spartan Fund annual donor level and then Spartan Points.

FOOTBALL & BASKETBALL **PARKING**

REQUESTING | Requests for parking passes must be made by June 30. Contact the Spartan Ticket Office at (517) 355-1610.

ELIGIBILITY | Must be a season ticket holder in the requested sport and meet the minimum Spartan Fund donor level per sport:

- Football: \$250 Sparty Club level or above.
- Men's Basketball: \$500 Green & White level or above.

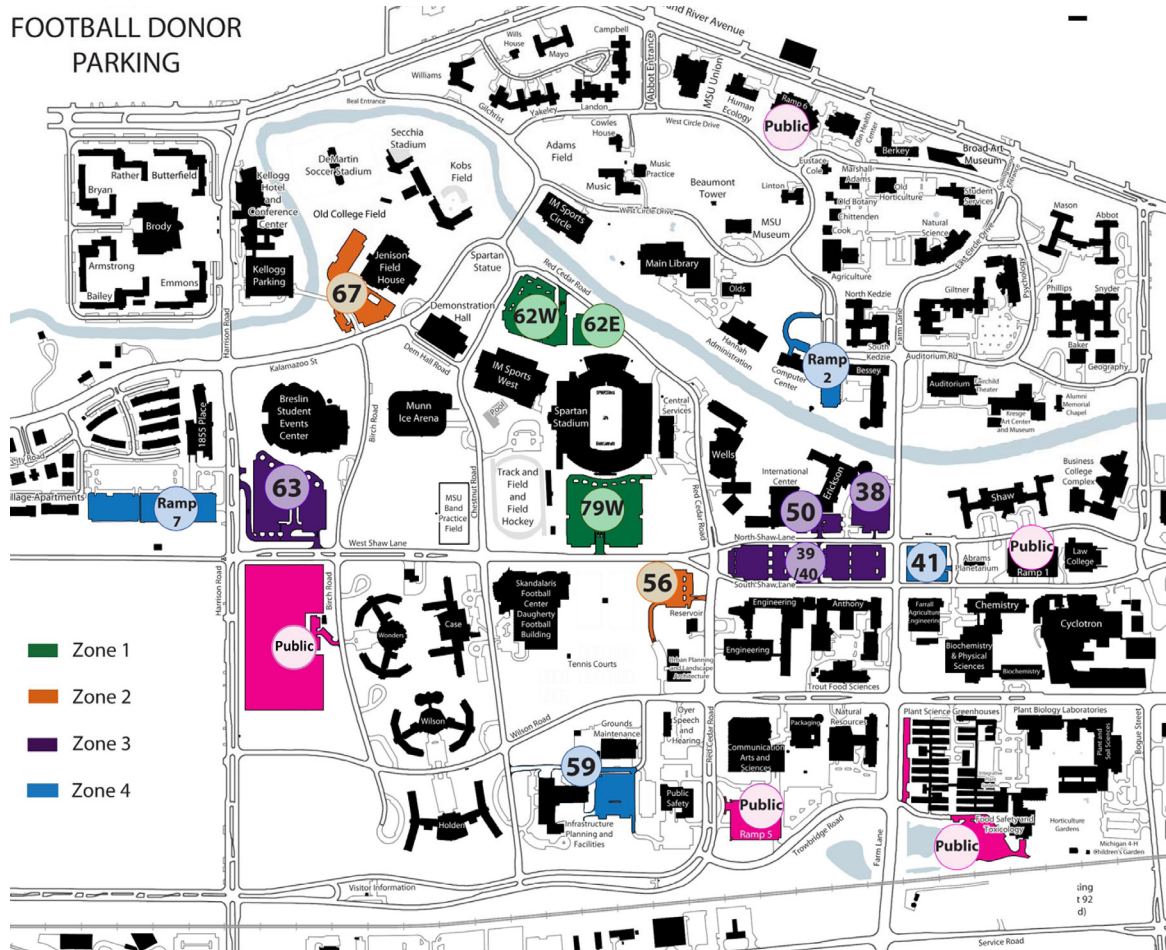
ALLOCATION | Parking passes and lot location are allocated annually based on our Spartan Fund Donor Priority System, determined first by Spartan Fund donor level and then by Spartan Points. The deadline to influence your donor level and Spartan Points is June 30.

DETAILS | Obtaining a parking pass cannot be guaranteed due to demand, likewise, specific lots cannot be guaranteed. Parking passes are allocated on a season basis. Single game parking passes are not available through Spartan Fund.

(Engineering Research C)

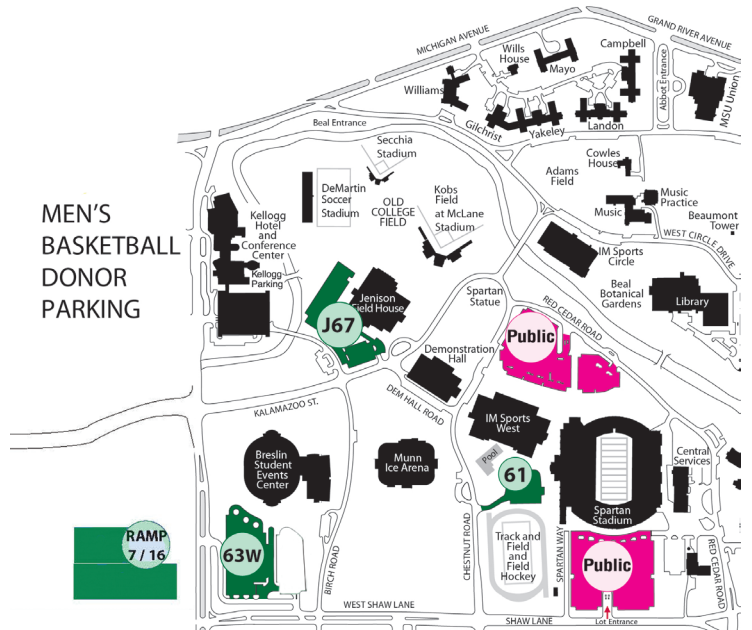

MATCHING GIFTS

Check with your employer to determine if your donation to MSU Athletics is eligible for a matching gift.

DONOR-ADVISED FUNDS & PRIVATE FOUNDATIONS

Per IRS regulations, gifts from donor-advised funds or private foundations must be toward 100% tax-deductible designations and cannot receive benefits.

PLANNED GIVING

Gifts in the form of life income, charitable lead trusts, and/or bequests are common ways to state your intentions of leaving a future gift to MSU Athletics.

SEAT PREMIUMS

Effective January 1, 2018, seat premiums are no longer tax deductible. Please consult your tax advisor(s) for details.

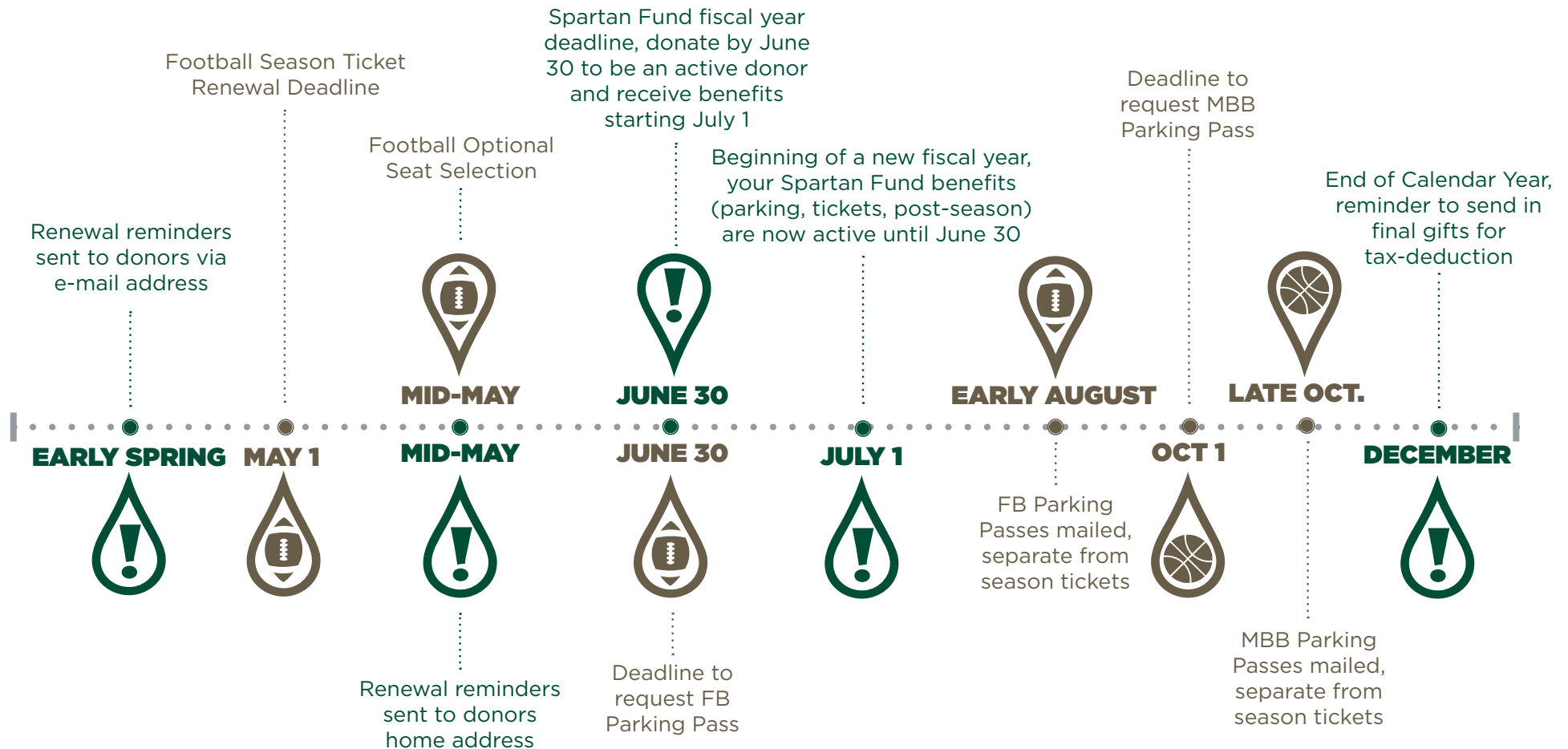


WOMEN'S GOLF
